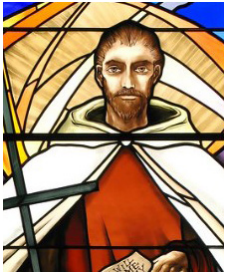

Saint John of the Cross



John d'Ypez was a contemporary and co-worker of Saint Teresa of Jesus. He was born in her native place, Avila, in 1542, and was blessed by God with a saintly mother who trained him in the school of Christ, until the youth thirsted for nothing more ardently than to become a living-copy of his suffering Master. At the age of twenty-one, he entered the Carmelite monastery at Medina, and took there the name of "John of the Cross." He laboured with Saint Teresa in the reform of their great Order, and was himself the first barefooted or discalced Carmelite His virtue was proved and perfected by many extraordinary trials; but all his sufferings served only to increase his profound spirit of humility and mortification. He died on December 14, 1591; and God glorified His servant by numerous miracles.

Prayer of Peace (By St John of the Cross)

O Blessed Jesus, grant me stillness of soul in Thee. Let Thy mighty calmness reign in me. Rule me, O thou King of gentleness, King of peace. Give me control, control over my words, thoughts and actions. From all irritability, want of meekness, want of gentleness, O dear Lord, deliver me. By thine own deep patience give me patience, stillness of soul in Thee. Make me in this, and in all, more and more like Thee. Amen.

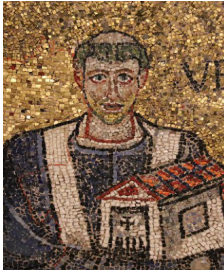
