# **Nativity of the Lord**



#### Christmas

This is the annual commemoration of the birth of Jesus Christ, celebrated by about three billion Christian people throughout the world. When Mary and Joseph were on their way to attend the enumeration work ordered by the Emperor, Mary suffered labor pain and they have to stay only in a cattle shed in Bethlehem, as they could not get room

in the inn and in the cattle shed Jesus was born. Previously Christmas was celebrated on January 6 every year as per the Julian calendar and in 534 A.D. the Christmas day on January 6 was declared a holiday by the Roman Government. From 1743 onwards the Christmas date was changed to December 25 as per the Gregorian calendar, as declared by Pope Julius-I. Christmas is also called Xmas, where the "X" represents the first Greek letter of the Greek word Kristos, meaning Savior or Christ. The word mass means celebration or feast. Christmas derived from "Christs mass" meaning celebration of Christ. The use of Christmas tree during Christmas was first done by Scandinavians, who worshipped trees on festival days, before becoming Christians.
